

# PS Success joins fleet

**Echuca has another paddlesteamer to add to its fleet - almost.**

**The derelict hull of the PS Success was trucked to Echuca from Mildura on Wednesday after being given to Campaspe Shire by the Rivers and Riverboat Historical and Preservation Society.**

**Built in 1877 in Moama, the PS Success was the last paddlesteamer to carry wool on the Murray and Darling Rivers, bringing 876 bales down the flooded Darling in 1956.**

**The society has given up a 10-year battle to fund the restoration of the PS Success which it had rescued from the bottom of the Murray, offering the boat to council to restore at the Port of Echuca.**

**Council will seek funding to restore the boat, with its restoration expected to provide a hands-on, interactive history lesson for visitors to the port.**
