Passing Yelta Aboriginal Mission site (1868), Junction of the Anabranh and Murray,, Fort Courage (Fishing Club), Anabranh Woolshed, remains of PS Sapphire, site of old Moorna Mail Change, remains of Emerald Barge, Moorna station Homestead of 1864, Frenchman's Creek Entrance to Lake Victoria. Moor overnight near Lock 9 – with time to walk and explore the Kulnine steam Pump.

Overnight mooring near site of proposed Chowilla Dam – 1963)
